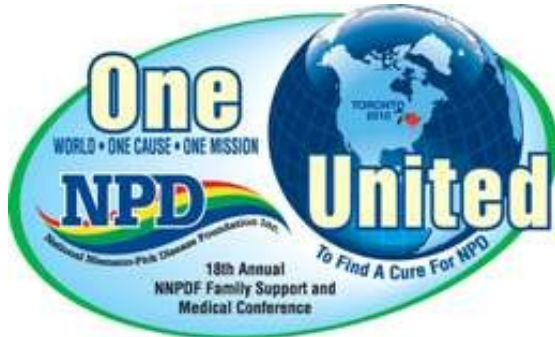




CCNNPDF 2010 Highlights
